## Church History

University Lutheran Church (UniLu) belongs to the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America (ELCA) and springs from the heritage of a South Carolina town and university known by the common namesake of Clemson. Established in 1950 on 111 Sloan Street—and preceded by decades of campus worship services for the military cadets of then Clemson College—the UniLu of today is a unified community of local families and university students. The first church building was built in 1950 and is now our Fellowship Hall. The groundbreaking of our present church took place in December 1988.
