CHRISMON WORKSHOP JULY 30

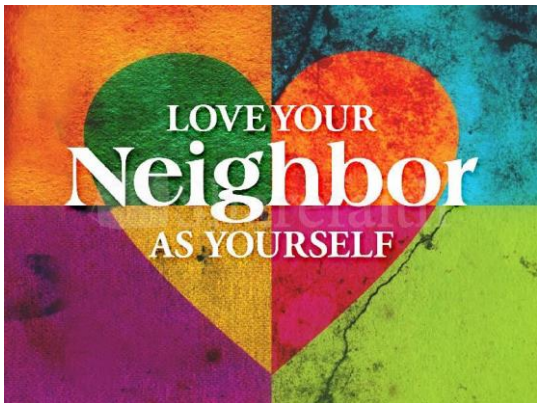
