Youth Worker Position

The UniLu Congregation Council has approved adding a part-time Youth Worker to our staff to help expand our youth ministry. This person will be present for Sunday morning worship and Sunday School on most Sundays as well as plan activities for the various ages to supplement the formal Sunday School curriculum. The Youth Worker will have a love of God and of children. This position is open to UniLu members as well as non-members. It is expected that the person will work between 10 and 20 hours a week and be paid at an hourly rate of \$12.00 to \$13.50 per hour. A detailed Position Description is posted on both the Narthex and Youth News Boards. Persons interested in the position should apply by providing a resume to Pastor Jon by the end of June. The position will begin in August.
