The 2018-19 Flu season is coming. Influenza is a very contagious respiratory illness that can cause mild to severe illness and can be deadly - especially to the very young, elderly and those with certain chronic health conditions. It takes about two weeks after vaccination for antibodies that protect against flu to develop in the body, so make plans to get vaccinated early in Fall, before flu season begins. The CDC recommends that people get a flu vaccine by the end of October. Flu shots can be obtained at many local pharmacies and most insurance plans pay for the vaccine.

Clemson Area Ministers' Cook-Off

Ministers from 14 area congregations will be showing off their culinary skills in support of Safe Harbor shelter for victims of domestic violence. Pastor Jon will be serving Shredded Beef Tacos to the eager tasters. Weather permitting, WYFF weatherman John Cessarich will broadcast “John on The Road” from the cook-off. Taste tickets at \$1.00 each will be available at the door.

South Carolina continues to have very high rates of criminal domestic violence usually ranking as one of the top ten states for percentage of women killed by men for the past 20 years. Safe Harbor provides a continuum of services for adult and child victims of domestic violence in Greenville, Anderson, Oconee and Pickens counties. Services provided include emergency housing, meals, counseling, clothing, parenting classes, and referrals to other support groups. When clients leave the shelters, Safe Harbor helps furnish housing needs and basic clothing. All proceeds from the Cook-Off will be shared between the Oconee and Anderson County shelters.
