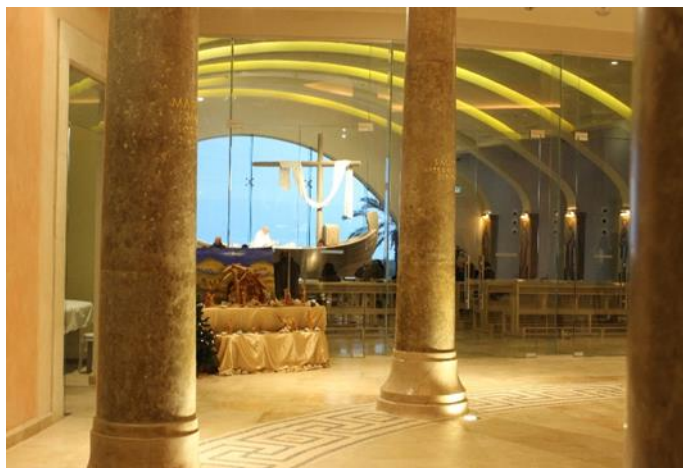

This worship space houses the Women's Atrium, dedicated to the women involved in Jesus' ministry, as well as the Boat Chapel overlooking the Sea of Galilee. The beauty and simplicity of the space made it very peaceful. Realizing how few spaces are dedicated to the early women of the church made it special. On each of the columns are the name(s) of prominent women in the gospels with one pillar remaining blank. This unnamed pillar represents all the women who currently follow Jesus. Simple yet dramatic. ## Epiphany Youth Event

Epiphany is often called the season of light and the youth of University Lutheran Church chose the Sunday of Epiphany to share God's light with others. The Senior youth group (composed of middle school and high school youth) organized an inter-generational painting party event for the congregation to help provide comfort and light to area children who are unwell. The group painted 24 Hope Globes, hand painted night-lights that are distributed to hospital-bound children in the South Carolina Upstate by The Hope Globe project, a local charity. They also strung elastic in 90 colorful scrub hats. These hats are given to children undergoing surgery in a local hospital to help ease their anxiety before their procedures. They supplied enough hats for a week's worth of surgeries for children. Another painting party is scheduled as part of Operation Inasmuch in March.
