## UNILU ENDOWMENT FUND DISTRIBUTIONS

University Lutheran Church's Endowment Fund has almost \$140,000.00 in it. Since this is over \$100,000, we have made distributions from the fund. The following organizations have received contributions: the Water Mission in Charleston, SC, which builds safe water and sanitation facilities around the

world, the Legacy Home of Recovery in Six Mile, SC, which provides a home and rehabilitation for addicts, Clemson Community Care, Golden Corner Food Pantry, Gleaning House Food Pantry in Pickens, SC, the Shaw Center for Housing and Economic Growth, Zak Lindler, our Seminary Student, the Paw Pantry, which is the student run food pantry at Clemson, and, seed money for a food pantry for UNILU students at Clemson. In total, \$25,000 was contributed. If you have any questions, please let me know.
