DECEMBER CONGREGATIONAL MEETING OUTCOME

The meeting was called to order, and an opening prayer was offered by Pastor Jon Heiliger. The following agenda items were presented and voted on.

- The congregation warmly recognized the 24 years of service to the church by Jon and Renee Heiliger by giving them a standing ovation. Their Christian journey is quite remarkable. He gave up a successful business career, she went to work while he was in seminary for four years... all while caring for two beautiful daughters. This couple heard the calling of God and answered it, what courage, what faith! Congratulations on a job well done.
- There will be a farewell reception for Jon & Renee on Sunday, January 26th in between services.
- The congregation unanimously approved the minutes from April 14, 2024 congregation meeting as written.
- The financial budget for the calendar year 2025 was presented by Jean Mehlman, Chairperson of the Financial Committee. It should be noted that the budget had a modest surplus and was prepared prior to Pastor Heiliger's announcement of his retirement. The congregation unanimously approved the budget as prepared.

- The congregation unanimously approved the appointment of Ms. Tamie

 Herin to fulfill the final year on Council of Ms. Katie Caterino, who resigned
 earlier this year. Congratulations and thank to Ms. Tamie Herin for her
 willingness to serve.
- The congregation voted to appoint Ms. Kim Lanier, Ms. Tammy Mckinney, and Ms. Carol Miller for three-year terms on Council beginning in January of 2025. Congratulations and thank you to all of you for your willingness to serve.
- · A review of the parish's 2024 Annual Goals was then presented. The construction phase of the Embracing Inclusivity (EI) campaign has drawn to a close. The four bathrooms in the administration/education building have been renovated closer to ADA compliance and critical interior and exit doors have been widened and or automated. EI Fund Raising Campaign is still ongoing as there remain outstanding pledges. A second goal was to increase the participation of children and LCM students in the Sunday worship services. The success of this initiative is on view almost every Sunday.
- Finally, with the blessing and encouragement Bishop Ginny Aebischer the congregation unanimously approved the initiation of an Internal Discernment for the candidacy of Pastor Josh Kestner to fulfill the role of University Lutheran's Parish Pastor prior to any external search.

The congregation commissioned a four-member subcommittee consisting of Ms. Tamie Herin (chairperson), Ms. Carol Miller, Michael Scott, and Zoie Bowers (LCM student) to discern with Pastor Josh the week of January 13th. Should you have a question for him or his candidacy you can pose it to one of the subcommittee members or pose it directly to him.

Please remember, this is as much a discernment process for him as it is for us. Consequently, do not hesitate to openly express your support for him directly to him and amongst the congregation.

With the subcommittee's input the Council will vote on Pastor Josh Kestner's candidacy on January 20th. Depending on the outcome, the Council could convene a congregational meeting in early February for a vote.

The congregation voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting.

A commissioning prayer for the four newly elected Council members was offered by Pastor Jon Heiliger.

A closing prayer was offered by Pastor Josh Kestner.
