# UNIVERSITY LUTHERAN'S CAPITAL RESERVE ACCOUNT

During the Embracing Inclusivity (EI) campaign, a financial question was posed at one of our congregational meetings. Why not just use the Capital Reserve designated gift account, which had approximately \$105,000 at that time?

Both the Council & Property Committee thought we ought to hold those funds in reserve, should we lose another one of the five archaic 4-ton HVAC compressors in the Education/Administrative wing, which eventually happened.

The EI fund-raising campaign ultimately raised \$127,000 which combined with the Capital Reserve account allowed the Church Council to initiate a proactive campaign to:

- Fully restore the lighting in the Sanctuary.
- Provide 24/7 electronic access to both the Narthex & LCM areas.
- Renovate four bathrooms, add an LCM Shower, widen the entrances into our educational classrooms, and replace the flooring.
- Replace the ancient Heating & Cooling systems in the Fellowship Hall and the Education/Administrative wing.
- Address the lifted sidewalks in the lower parking lot as well as the sinking patio on the south side of the Fellowship Hall.

All this long overdue spending means the condition of our buildings and grounds are much improved and much more accessible to all those who wish to be a part of our church family.

Another important consequence, however, is that our Capital Reserve account is now down to approximately \$8,000. With your support we hope to replenish this vital contingency fund over time with designated pledges and gifts to the Capital Reserve fund.

# HELP WITH TRANSPORTATION FOR REFUGEE HOPE UPSTATE

While Lutheran Services Carolinas has decreased staff and vacated our building because of financial changes, many of the folks involved are still supporting refugee services in the community. Refugee Hope Upstate has offices at First Baptist Church, and they are enlisting helpers for some summer transportation.

Over the summer, there is an ESL program for refugee women. There are 44 women with 18 children who are eligible for the education program. They utilize congregations with vans and buses to help transport the women and children to classes and childcare. There is a need for a driver in the morning for drop-off (7:30/8:00 am) and pick-up (11:30 am). The need is for the following dates: June 2-5 and June 9-12. The driver can use the UniLu church van, provided they have insurance and sign an agreement/waiver.
