FROM PASTOR JOSH

We've made it through some pretty difficult weeks of weather. While the views from the window might have been picturesque, the roads were quite dangerous and thousands of folks were without power for a period of time. Above, you can see a

slab of ice that is still pretty solid in the upper parking lot because it does not get much sun. Today, it's finally starting to disappear.

The city dropped some sand on top of the ice a couple of days ago. The sand is able to help with the melting, but it also provides some traction on a slippery surface. If you've ever tried to walk on ice (or taken a tumble on it), you know how precarious it is.

Sometimes, faith feels a bit like walking on ice. We're not so sure where the next step will take us. We never quite feel steady. We're trying to catch our balance as different things nudge us in one direction or another. And all the while, we're trying to grab a hold of something invisible - a God who promises to be there, but is difficult to comprehend and trust.

So, I've been leaning on words like these from Psalm 18 this week: *"I love you, Lord, my strength. The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold."* When things feel slippery, where do we find our footing? What rocks show up in our lives for us to grab onto for refuge or strength?
